	<input type="checkbox"/> Conduct practical safety prep, know local emergency #s & facilities.	<input type="checkbox"/> Int'l: know currency exchange rate, download exchange app for quick conversions.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Buy travel insurance.	<input type="checkbox"/> Int'l: plan how to get cash in the local currency—ATM upon arrival or buy from bank before you go.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Know what to do in case of theft (e.g., phone, wallet, passport loss).	<input type="checkbox"/> Int'l: make copies of all credit and banking cards, share with a trusted family/friend.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Step 12: Pack & Prep Your Home Before Your Trip	<input type="checkbox"/> Int'l: have a plan to keep valuables safe with secure bags & preventative measures.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Make a packing list, or borrow a free universal list one like this.	<input type="checkbox"/> Int'l: ensure ample funds into your checking/ATM accounts for emergencies & bills.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Itemize the prep you need to do for your trip & to close your house.	<input type="checkbox"/> Step 14: Stay Connected While You Travel (International Travel)
<input type="checkbox"/> Plan for how to get around your planned destination.	<input type="checkbox"/> Set how you plan to stay connected —via Wifi, int'l plans from mobile carrier, or eSIM tech.
